Feedback from Community Safety Forum 24th Feb 2009

John Plummer made the following observations from the meeting.

- There was not enough focus on priorities at the forum. (A view supported by Lloyd Hynes and Dave Rollings). ACSG should take the lead and identify priorities.
- Fresh issues raised were; Illegal use of mobile phones; Woburn St Pedestrian Crossing; Cold Calling; Inconsiderate Parking (Highway Code 243)

Priorities

Following a discussion the following priorities were identified and *agreed*:

1. **Neighbourhood Policing.** There should be more daytime police visibility within the town centre. *Post meeting note: John Plummer has written to Sgt Nigel Denham at Ampt Hill Police Station. Action JP*
2. **Disorderly Conduct.** (esp Fri/Sat Evenings) ACSG to write to Ampt Hill Town Council (ATC) and recommend an additional camera in the town centre. (e.g Mobile type as used in Sandy and Biggleswade). *Post meeting note: John Plummer has written to ATC. Action JP*
3. **Speeding.** ACSG to volunteer assistance with any activities. *Post meeting note: John Plummer has met and written to Sgt Nigel Denham at Ampt Hill Police Station. Action JP*
4. **Jack and Jill Playgroup.** PC Element to be informed of youth anti social behaviour and vandalism affecting the Jack and Jill Playgroup playground and building. *Post meeting note: DR has since contacted PC Element and awaits reply. Action DR*
