# Amphill Community Safety Group

Current ongoing priorities:

- Neighbourhood Policing
- Disorderly Conduct
- Speeding (Pedestrian Safety)
- ACSG Pro-activity

# Amphill Community Safety Group

- Anti-Social Behaviour. Current focus is Willow Way area, and town centre. Find causes rather than just tackling the effects.
- Tackle speeding issues in Amphill Town Centre (20mph zone). Examining Shared Space concept.
- Talking to residents about speeding issues.
- Monitoring parking issues in Bedford Street, Park Hill, Oliver Street and Waitrose area.
- How to engage young people in community activities in consultation with Central Bedfordshire Council

# Amphill Community Safety Group

## Achievements:

- Surgeries in Waitrose with Police, and Fire and Rescue Service.
- Support Police surgeries when Mobile Police Station is located in Waitrose car park.
- New bridge built to replace unsafe one on footpath between Amphill and Maulden.
- Increased Police patrols in Willow Way area.
- Working in partnership with others.
